What flower do you like? Cherry blossoms? Sunflowers? I like roses. Fukuyama has one million roses now. There are more than 10 roses which have "Fukuyama" in their names. For example, (1). Roses are popular in Japan. Please look at the table. It shows the shipment numbers of three flowers. These flowers sell well. Roses sell as well as carnations. Lilies don't sell as well as carnations. These flowers are used in ceremonies and parties. They are also used as presents and decorations. From the table, you can see that the rose is one of the most popular flowers in Japan, can't you?

Why do people in Fukuyama like roses? Roses have a relationship to the history of our city. 80% of Fukuyama was destroyed in August, 1945. People were doing their best to rebuild their city in the mid-1950s. Some people planned to plant flowers because they wanted to make a peaceful city and have peace of mind. Citizens started to plant about 1,000 roses in an area which is Rose Park now. This movement made people start to plant roses in their towns.

Citizens in Fukuyama started the "Rose Festival." 47 citizens who loved roses held the "First Rose Exhibition" in 1956. The "First Fukuyama Rose Exhibition" was held by Fukuyama City in 1957. The name was changed in 1968. It became the

"Rose Festival." The "First Rose Festival" was held in the same year. People have made an effort to develop their towns with roses after World War II. They thought that growing roses would make their towns beautiful. This idea became "Rose Mind." Thanks to their actions, we will have the 20th "World Rose Convention 2025 in Fukuyama."

Now, I will tell you about "World Rose Convention 2025 in Fukuyama." This is an international meeting. Experts on roses and people who love roses from all over the world get together and share information about roses. Exhibitions, tours and workshops are held during the meeting. They had the meeting in your country two years ago.

There are some events in Fukuyama, too. I will introduce two interesting events. The first one is an event to make original songs to introduce our city. If you make an original song, you can play and sing it in front of the audience. I have some friends who sing well, so I want them to join this event.

The second one is a volunteer activity for high school and junior high school students. They translate a picture book. They will translate it during summer vacation and will have a party to show the translated book in January. People from all over the world can understand "Rose Mind." The story is based on the history of Fukuyama which I told you. Participants of the meeting can get the books as presents.

I am going to join this volunteer activity. I have been interested in volunteer activities because we can have good experiences. To join the activity, I have studied the history of our city and the actions of its citizens. (2) I am proud of Fukuyama now. I am excited that people all over the world will read our picture books. I hope to meet many people at the party. Please watch it on the Internet.
